#### ➤ Review of School Plan Strategic Directions- consultation with P&C.

- Moving to 2 instead of 3 strategic directions to refine plan and make it more manageable. No loss of integrity as the current plan was developed in consultation with community. Strategic Direction 3 initiatives will be encompassed within Strategic Direction 1 and 2 as activities. The Initiatives in Strategic Directions 1 and 2 will be renamed to encompass all of the agreed initiatives in the original version of the School Plan. - In evaluating this plan we will move to the latest version of the School Excellence Framework V3.
- Strategic Direction 1: Personalised Learning/ Data and Assessment
  - Parent Teacher interviews underway and continuing across next couple of weeks. Setting of personalised student learning goals
  - Assistant Principal Curriculum and Instruction (Sarah) supporting teachers K-6 to implement new English and maths syllabuses.
  - Teacher professional learning- strong focus on curriculum using Teaching Sprint model
  - Teaching Staff – Twilight PL Session Week 11 from 3:15- 6:15 on Curriculum Reform. This is an in-lieu session for a ½ day Term 4 Staff Development Day.
  - NAPLAN testing underway
- Strategic Direction 2:
  - Community Engagement including Aboriginal Education
    - Increasing opportunities to engage with community. Egs Surfest initiative, working with Westfield and Mitch Reeves, Kinder morning tea, Parent interviews, Harmony Day, seeking opportunities for extra curricula groups to perform, meetings with Kotara Community of Schools to engage in wider networks, PSSA sporting opportunities and carnivals.
    - Implementation of new Personalised Learning Plan for Aboriginal Students

- Term 1 Yarn Up in Week 11 to brainstorm ideas, gain feedback and consult Aboriginal Education Initiatives. Survey to be sent for those Aboriginal families unable to attend.
- Students 3-6 learning the Australian National Anthem in the Awabakal language
- Wellbeing
  - Implementation of DoE new Behaviour Policy
  - Review Belair Behaviour Management Plan in accordance with new policy
  - Implementation of wellbeing programs and strategies K-6 including Grow Your Mind, Restorative Practice and Zones of Regulation
