## ➤ School Improvement Plan – Big picture Updates since last meeting

### SD1:

#### Data and Assessment:

- AP C&I position- Sarah Jardine successful candidate- commences role in 2023.
- 2 positions to fill; 3days a week assistant principal and 3 days a week LaST
- ICAS- survey of parents. Numbers dropped- significant cost to school.

#### NAPLAN results: Things to note:

Year 3 Reading: just over 70% of kids in top 2 bands which is slightly above SSSG

Year 3 Numeracy: About 55% in top two bands, which sits below our target. Interestingly, SSSG just over 50% in top two bands

Year 5 Reading: 70% of students in top two bands, above SSSG.

Year 5 Numeracy: 53% of students in top two bands, slightly above SSSG, but below our target

#### School Targets

- Trending towards Top 2 bands literacy and numeracy target
- reached target of 71% in top 2 bands for reading
- trending downward away from lower bound of target in top 2 bands for numeracy- above SSG and State who also have same downward trend.
