
Belair Public School P&C Principal's Report

School Improvement Plan

Strategic Direction 1: Data and Assessment/Personalised Learning

- AP C&I and Executive attending ConnectEd Middle leadership Conference to engage with current educational research.
- Belair has been recognised by the Department's Literacy and Numeracy team for excellence and or improvement. The Literacy and Numeracy team plan to engage with Belair in Term 2 and 3 to learn about practices that contribute to literacy and numeracy excellence and improvement. Members of the Literacy and Numeracy team will arrange interviews with our school to understand practices that may benefit other schools.
- NAPLAN results will be reported against 4 proficiency standards rather than numerical bands as in previous years.

- Needs additional support.

 - The school has booked Ysafe, a specialist cyber safety organisation to deliver Cyber -safety workshops for staff, students and parents next week. We strongly encourage participation as this is a growing area of concern in terms of student wellbeing. The parent workshop is Wednesday evening at 5:30pm in hall, \$5 donation at the door. Student permission notes were emailed, cost to attend \$10.
 - Language lessons in French have commenced.

 - Newcastle University Leadership Project- We have had 2 visits from the team at the university The program aims at Improving Children's leadership skills. Targeted for Stage 2 and 3 students. Random selection of 60 students to be surveyed as part of the project- Stage 3 parents may receive this request.

 - all test reports have been below minimal standards to date.

 - Remediation team will work with school and the contractor we have hired to . do our playground works when putting remediation plan together.
